We are pleased to announce the 2nd edition of the **Symposium on Intermediate-energy Heavy Ion Collisions (iHIC22)** that will take place at the Institute of Modern Physics, Chinese Academy of Sciences (Lanzhou, China) during **October 7th – 10th, 2022**. October 7th is reserved for Student Day.

Scope of the Symposium

Several large-scale facilities for nuclear and particle researches including the High Intensity Heavy Ion Accelerator Facility (HIAF) in China are under construction. In order to stimulate interests and enrich the physics programs, the symposium is intended to provide a convenient venue and ample time for discussions on experimental and theoretical problems and future directions. The program will cover the current state of research and the anticipated trends in various centers and facilities in the world. All talks are by invitation. The registration fee for attending the symposium is 1500 CNY or 200 USD.

iHIC22 will concentrate on the advances and future perspectives in experimental and theoretical studies of the nuclear Equation of State, QCD phase structure, hypernuclei production and exotics in nuclei. Meanwhile,
