Where is Uppsala?



- ▶ With a population of 200,000 inhabitants, Uppsala is the 4th largest city in Sweden.
- ▶ It is located about 70 km north of Sweden's capital city Stockholm (40 minutes by train).
- ▶ The airport (Stockholm, ARN) is located half-way between Uppsala and Stockholm:
 - ▶ 18 minutes by train,
 - ▶ 40 minutes by bus,
 - ▶ 25 minutes by taxi.

Some Uppsala Landmarks

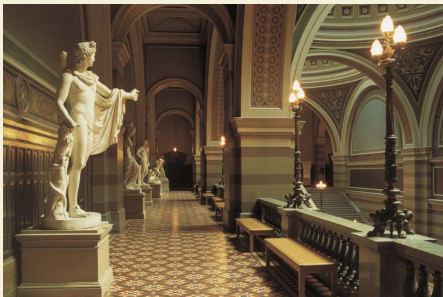


- ▶ The oldest university in northern Europe, founded in 1477, with a large number of traditions, symbols and festivities that make Uppsala truly unique.
- ▶ The largest cathedral in Scandinavia, a pink castle and Linnaeus gardens.
- ▶ Thirteen student nations (at the core of the student life in Uppsala), each dating back to the 17th century. One of them will host the conference dinner. Back-up option: the castle!
- ▶ About 1500 hotels rooms and many restaurants in the city centre.

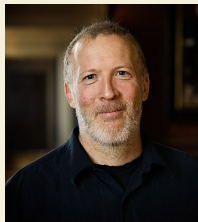
Conference Venue

Higgs 2024 will take place in the **Uppsala University Main Building**, built in the 1880s. It is conveniently located in the city centre, at a walking distance from hotels, restaurants and cozy cafés.

Three rooms with 221, 141 and 102 seats have been booked for the plenary session and two parallel sessions, respectively.
