

Linear Collider workshops in Asia

- International linear collider community has been organizing two workshops every year, one as the global workshop and the other as a regional workshop either at NA, EU, or Asia. In 2014, the regional workshop was held at FNAL organized by NA organizers. The global workshop was LCWS2014 at Belgrade, Serbia. Spring 2015 is the turn for a Asian regional workshop.
- The last regional workshop in Asia was at Daegu, Korea, 2012, being organized jointly by the Linear Collider Physics and Detector Working Group and GDE.

Since 2013, LCC has taken over GDE. In order to meet new circumstances, it was decided that

- KEK, ACFA and LCC co-host the workshop
- Detector sessions are divided to R&D group meetings and concept group meetings.
- Physics and accelerator sessions are as usual

The workshop is held at a critical moment for ILC in Japan. Therefore, ILC Tokyo Event is organized on April 22, for a special focus on ILC in Japan. A symposium with people from various fields will be organized at Tokyo, which will be followed by ILC48 Food Festa in the night.
