## First evidence of $B \rightarrow h_c K$ and Recent Results on $X$ and $Y$ from Belle

$X(3872)$  and  $Y(4260)$  are famous for their exotic nature. We present search for  $B \rightarrow Y(4260)K$ ,  $B \rightarrow X(3872)(\rightarrow \chi_{c1}\pi^0)K$  and  $B \rightarrow X(3915)(\rightarrow \chi_{c1}\pi^0)K$  at Belle based on the full data sample accumulated by the Belle experiment at KEKB asymmetric energy  $e^+e^-$  collider. As no signal is found, upper limit on the product branching fraction is provided.

We also report evidence of  $B \rightarrow h_c K$  along with first observation of the decay  $\eta_c(2S) \rightarrow p\bar{p}\pi^+\pi^-$  in Belle.
